This displays a list of content tags currently defined in the system. From here the administrator can add, edit, view usage, and delete tags. Content tags are used to group content into subjects outside of their Content Category storage locations to make for easy searching on the [Browse Page](#) and other search panels. Tags can be used by the following content:

1. Discussions
2. Reports
3. Dashboards
4. Storyboards
5. Images
6. Annotations

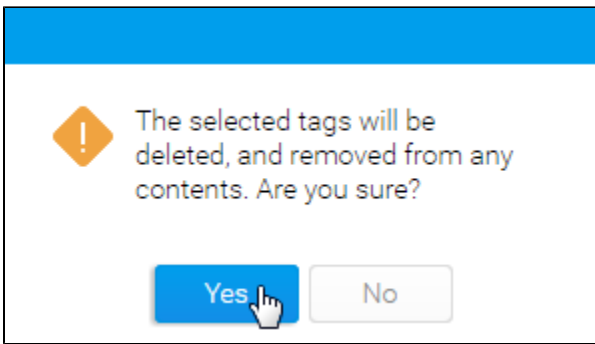
