### **Data Source List**

#### top

The Data Sources list shows you all the available connections that have been defined in the system. This list is accessed by clicking on Administration in the main navigation menu and selecting the Admin Console option from the drop down list.

## Add Connection

### top

In order to create a new Data Source Connection an administrator will have to click on the Add button at the bottom of the Data Sources list in the Admin Console.

Once you add a connection you will be taken to the Connection Details page where you will be prompted to fill in required connection parameters. Alternatively, you can create a new connection through the various system navigation menus available. See Creating a Basic Data Source Connection for a walk through.

See Understanding Connection Parameters for more information on the various options that are available.

Note: if you have a license restriction on the number of source systems you can use you will encounter an error if you try create a connection that pushes the total number over your limit. To fix this you will need to delete a connection to make room, or adjust your licence.

# **Edit Connection**

In order to edit a connection you will need to click on the name in the Data Sources list in the Admin Console.

Once selected you will be taken to the Connection Details page where you can adjust the connection parameters that have been previously defined.

# **Delete Connection**

In order to delete a connection you will need to locate it in the Data Sources list in the Admin Console and click on the x button on the right of the row.

Once clicked, you will be taken to a confirmation page that will list the usage of the connection, so that if any Views rely on it the administrator is informed before deleting.
