

Google API Key Configuration

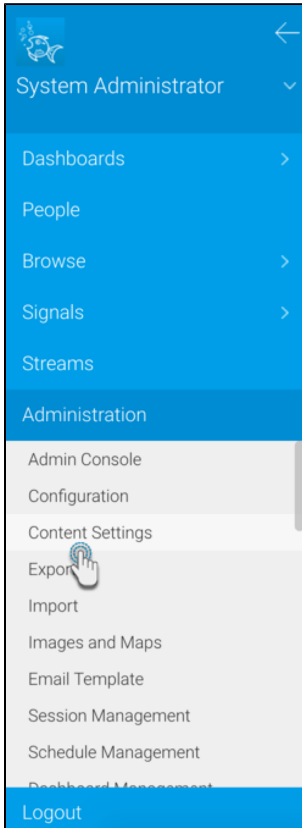
All Google map charts will require a Google API key that administrators must set up in Yellowfin before using the charts. You can find out more about the Google API key [here](#).

Charts that require this key include Google Map, and GIS Google Map charts.

Configuring Google API Key

Upon receiving their Google API key, administrators can set it up in Yellowfin. Here's how:

1. Navigate to the **Content Settings** page (left side menu > Administration > Content Settings).



2. Select **Chart Settings**, then expand the **Map Settings** section.

Map Settings

GIS Base Layer
Specify whether or not to display a base layer underneath maps to provide location context by default. ☒

Google API Access
Specify if Google Maps can be used. These require internet access to work. ☒

Google Maps Point Limit
Specify the maximum number of single points to be displayed at any one time.

Google GIS Label Background
Define the color to be used for Map Label backgrounds.

Google GIS Label Border
Define the color to be used for GIS Maps Label borders.

Google Maps API Key
Provide the Google Maps API Key to be used to generate Google Maps.

Google Maps Premium API Key
Specify whether or not to interpret this API key as a premium ClientID. ☐

3. Copy or enter your Google API key into the **Google Maps API Key** field.

Google Maps API Key
Provide the Google Maps API Key to be used to generate Google Maps.

4. Save the updated settings.
